FISHING RULES

Our fish are replenished periodically through the season from both California Department of Fish & Game and private hatcheries. Good Luck!

1. All persons engaged in fishing activities must have a valid fishing license issued by California Department of Fish and Game, and have paid the established fees to GVL Recreation, Inc. Both must be visible, and available to be checked by lake employees upon request. This pass is for the use of immediate family members only, and may be revoked if others use it.
2. The lake limit for trout is five (5) fish per day per person. Each fisher person must have their own individual stringer, with no more than five trout attached. All CDFG rules and regulations are in effect and enforced at Green Valley Lake.
3. Fish can not be cleaned in the lake. There is a fish cleaning station near the Boat House.
4. No fishing is allowed in the designated swimming area, at the east end of the lake. No swimming allowed in the fishing area.
5. No open fires are allowed around the lake. Barbeque grills are located in the picnic area.
6. Fishing is allowed from 5:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. daily. Locations are on the first come first served basis. On crowded days, fishing may be limited to one pole per person.
7. Foul language or inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. You may be asked to leave and your pass may be revoked.
8. All dogs must be on a 6 feet or shorter leash at all times (no expanding leashes allowed). We reserve the right to request that a dog be muzzled, per S.B. County Code.
9. No fishing is allowed from the dam except from boats.
10. No fishing is allowed in the Boat Dock area. During fish plants, there may be other "no fishing" areas to allow the fish to adjust to the lake.
11. "Catch and release" fishing is allowed with lures only. No "catch and release" when using bait.
12. No hip waders, float tubes or inflatable craft are allowed on the lake. Some types of inflatable craft are allowed in the swimming area.
13. No motorized boats of any type will be allowed on the lake.
14. Fishing tackle, bait and supplies are available from the Green Valley Lake merchants.
15. Portable toilets are placed around the lake for your convenience.
16. Always try to leave your area cleaner than you found it. Trash receptacles are located around the lake.
17. GVL Recreation, Inc. reserves the right to revoke any pass at anytime for non compliance with the lake rules.
