

**GVL RECREATION, INC.**  
**BOATING AND WATERCRAFT RULES**

One of the greatest ways to enjoy our lake is by boating. For just pleasure or fishing, it is a whole different way to see the lake and surrounding scenery. Enjoy!

1. The only boats permitted on the lake are rental boats at the Boat House, or boats owned by stockholders add the Green Valley Mutual Water Company with a current seasonal boat tag.
2. Boat tags can only be sold and used by stockholders of Green Valley Mutual Water Company. In addition, there shall be no rentals of stockholder watercrafts.
3. Stockholders may put their boats on the lake in April, on the date determined by the Board of Directors and must remove their boats by the end of October 31<sup>st</sup>. An impound fee of \$300.00 will be charged for boats placed on the lake before April 1<sup>st</sup> and left on the property after October 31<sup>st</sup>. Stockholder boats without a current year boat tag affixed to the boat by June 1<sup>st</sup> will be impounded. Shoreline tie up locations are on a first come, first basis and are set for the season. Stockholder boats placed on the lake after June 1<sup>st</sup> will be assigned a designated location at the discretion of the Lake Operations Manager. GVL RECREATION, INC. reserves the right to move or assign boat storage areas. A map showing the restricted areas is posted at the boathouse.
4. Boat occupants who are fishing must have a valid fishing license issued by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife and have paid the established fees to GVL RECREATION, INC. prior to leaving the shore.
5. No watercraft longer than 14 feet shall be allowed on the lake. No motorized boats of any type are allowed.
6. Occupants per watercraft must not exceed manufacturers maximum load limits.
7. Inflatable boats or float tubes are not allowed on the lake.
8. All occupants of watercrafts are required to have at least one type-2 personal flotation device per occupant of the boat. All watercrafts must have at least one type-4 throwable personal flotation device (cushion type, U.S. Coastguard approved) in the boat.
9. Children under 13 years of age are required to wear a new U.S. Coastguard approved personal flotation device while on and around the watercraft and the boat dock.
10. Swimming is not allowed from any watercraft.
11. Watercrafts are not allowed in the swimming area or to be tied up to swimming platforms. No transfer of occupants from one craft to another or to a swimming platform is permitted.
12. Foul language or inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. You may be asked to leave, and your past revoked.
13. Per San Bernardino County code, all dogs must be on a 6 foot or shorter leash always and reserve right to request that a dog be muzzled. Dogs are only allowed in the water at the designated "Dog Beach" area.
14. Always try to leave your area cleaner than when you find it. Trash receptacles are located around the lake.
15. In such a case where maintenance or emergency conditions exist, if instructed, lake users must remove themselves from lake property immediately, to secure a safe environment for the performance of duties.
16. All watercrafts must be in and docked by 8:00 PM. Watercrafts are not allowed on the lake from 8:00 PM to 5:30 AM.
17. All U.S. Coastguard and California Department of Fish and Wildlife rules apply and are to be followed.
