

**GVL RECREATION, INC.**  
**FISHING RULES**

Our fish are replenished periodically through the season from both the California Department of Fish and Wildlife and private hatcheries. Good luck!

1. All persons engaged in fishing activities must have a valid sport fishing license issued by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, and have paid the established fees to GVL Recreation, Inc. Both must be visible and available to be checked by Recreation Staff upon request. Shareholder fishing passes are for shareholder's and their immediate family members only and may be revoked if others use it.
2. The lake limit for fish species are as follows:
  - The trout limit is five (5) fish per day per person.
  - The Crappie limit is twenty-five (25) fish per day per person.
  - **Bass are catch and release only.**
3. Each fisherperson must have their own individual stringer, with no more than five trout attached.
4. **All CDFW rules and regulations are in effect and enforced at Green Valley Lake.**
5. Fish cannot be cleaned in the lake. There is a fish cleaning station near the Boat House.
6. No fishing is allowed in the designated swimming area, at the East End of the lake. Vice versa, there is no swimming in the designated fishing area.
7. No open fires are allowed around the lake.
8. Fishing is allowed from 5:30 AM to 8:00 PM daily. Locations are on a first come, first serve basis. On crowded days, fishing may be limited to one pole for person.
9. Foul language or inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. You may be asked to leave, and your pass may be revoked.
10. Per San Bernardino County code, all dogs must be on a 6 foot or shorter leash and reserve the right to request that a dog be muzzled. Dogs are only allowed in the water at the designated "Dog Beach" area.
11. No fishing is allowed from the dam except from boats.
12. No fishing is allowed in the boat dock area. During fishing plants, there may be other "no fishing" areas to allow the fish to adjust to the lake.
13. "Catch and release" fishing is allowed with lures only. No "catch and release" when using bait.
14. No hip waders, what tubes or inflatable craft you're allowed on the lake. Some types of inflatable craft are allowed in the swimming area.
15. No motorized boats of any type will be allowed on the lake.
16. Fishing tackle, bait and supplies are available from local Green Valley Lake merchants.
17. Portable toilets are placed around the lake for your convenience.
18. Always try to leave your area cleaner than when you find it. Trash receptacles are located around the lake.
19. GVL Recreation, Inc. reserves the right to revoke any pass at any time for noncompliance with the lake rules.
